

2003-2010 VW Touareg Radio Upgrade to Aftermarket Navigation DVD Player



It is an original **VW Touareg radio** head unit. You can enjoy radio or music from it freely. However, if you want more functions, you have to upgrade it. Remove it and install a new head unit is easy. You do not need to remove the trim panel. All you need to pay attention to is the installation of the new unit.

Therefore, if you have not brought a new unit, and you want to upgrade it yourself, you should choose a good one with good after-sale customer service. This kind of dealer will provide professional help when you meet problems during upgrade or usage.

If you have brought a new one, and it comes without warranty, installation instruction, or wiring diagram, you do not need to worry too much. You can go to a stereo upgrade center and ask for help. If you know how to install the unit, you can

do it yourself, too.

The followings are basic upgrade steps for a **VW Touareg radio** for your reference.

1. Remove the negative cable on vehicle battery before the upgrade. In addition, prepare four release keys for the upgrade.



2. Remove the old radio. There are four holes on the radio panel. Insert the release keys into the holes and hook the unit tightly. Then, pull the keys to drag the unit out of the dash gently. Before the unit is totally out of the dash, hold it with your hands and remove the wires at the back of it. Then, put the unit aside.



3. Install the new unit. Connect the new unit to the original wiring harness by referring to a wiring diagram from your dealer. Here is an example below. If you do not have it, and you are not sure how to connect the wires, please ask for help. After connection, put the unit into the dash and connect the negative cable on the vehicle battery. Then, turn on the unit and test the functions in it. **DONE!**
